



WATER SERVICE APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT

SPECIAL DISTRICT WATER SERVICE INFORMATION

The North Perry Avenue Water District is a political subdivision of Washington, termed a “special district” or a “municipal corporation”, and provides water to customers’ property subject to present and future District regulation. The District also follows applicable regulations of the State of Washington and the United States.

THE MISSION OF THE DISTRICT IS TO SUPPLY THE DISTRICT SERVICE AREA WITH ADEQUATE, HIGH QUALITY, POTABLE WATER FOR DOMESTIC, INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL USE. THE INFORMATION ON THIS PAGE SUMMARIZES IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT RECEIVING WATER SERVICE FROM THE DISTRICT.

WATER AVAILABILITY LETTER: Before connection, owners may be able to obtain a water availability letter, stating a fixed duration of six years from date of letter, upon payment of the applicable fee.

CONNECTION: To enable connection, the District may require water main extension to be performed by the applicant per the District Developer’s Manual and regulations applicable to water mains. Connection charges are applicable at the rates applicable when the connection is made. Future subdivision or density increases will necessitate additional connection charges. Connection charges, and the rates for water supplied, constitute a lien against the property served, subordinate only to real property taxes, and may be foreclosed by statutory action. The connection charges for this property have been calculated at current rates based upon the information supplied by the customer. The District is not responsible for the pressure or volume of flow, or for fluctuations in pressure or flow, or thermal expansion (due to check valve installation by North Perry Avenue Water District) at the time of connection or afterwards. Connection or reconnection to the District’s main without District approval is utility tampering, and also renders the owner and the property liable for water used, and/or the possibility of prosecution.

CONTINUED SERVICE: Connection and continued service requires compliance with all present and future District rules. For example, the customer shall notify the District prior to land use changes, subdivision or density increases on the property, or installation of any irrigation or **(fire)** sprinkler system, or of any alternative water supply (well): These require a backflow prevention device approved by the District. The District may shut off water to a property for health, operations, or financial reasons. ***BY APPLYING FOR OR ACCEPTING WATER SERVICE TO THE PROPERTY, THE CUSTOMER IS AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT TO INSPECT PREMISES FOR POSSIBLE HAZARDS TO THE SYSTEM FOR COMPLIANCE WITH DISTRICT REQUIREMENTS AS SUMMARIZED ABOVE.***

APPLICATION AGREEMENT PARAGRAPHS

WATER SERVICE TO THIS PROPERTY IS CONTINGENT UPON THE PROPERTY TO BE SERVED, BEING IN COMPLIANCE WITH RULES OF WASHINGTON STATE, KITSAP COUNTY, AND NORTH PERRY AVENUE WATER DISTRICT AT THE TIME OF CONNECTION. THE FEE FOR AN UNEXPIRED WATER AVAILABILITY LETTER WILL BE CREDITED AGAINST CONNECTION CHARGES (WHICH WILL BE CHARGED IN THE AMOUNT APPLICABLE AS OF THE TIME THAT CONNECTION IS MADE).

SERVICE CHARGES WILL START UPON SETTING OF METER OR CLOSING OF PROPERTY.

THE METER MAY BE LEFT OFF UNTIL SUCH TIME THE DISTRICT IS ASKED TO TURN IT ON. IF THE METER IS TURNED ON BY SOMEONE OTHER THAN A DISTRICT EMPLOYEE, A \$250.00 TAMPERING FEE WILL BE APPLIED TO THE BILL.

NO ALTERNATIVE WATER SUPPLY (SUCH AS A WELL) OR OTHER POTENTIAL SOURCE OF CONTAMINATION HAZARD MAY BE CONNECTED TO THE CUSTOMER'S PLUMBING OR OTHERWISE EXPOSED TO THE DISTRICT WATER SYSTEM WITHOUT USE AND MAINTENANCE OF AN APPROVED BACKFLOW PREVENTION DEVICE. Failure to notify the District or comply may result in termination of water service.

WATER SERVICE SHALL BE PROVIDED ONLY TO THE PROPERTY (LOT/PARCEL) THAT THE SERVICE/METER IS INTENDED FOR. A METER IS REQUIRED FOR EACH PARCEL/LOT.

IF A BOOSTER PUMP IS INSTALLED BY THE CUSTOMER AND NORTH PERRY AVE WATER DISTRICT HAS PROVIDED 30 PSI TO THE SERVICE AT THE METER THEN THE CUSTOMER WILL BEAR ALL COSTS FOR INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE AND THE REQUIRED BACKFLOW DEVICE.

WATER SERVICE SHALL BE INSPECTED AND TURNED ON/OFF BY NORTH PERRY AVE WATER DISTRICT EMPLOYEES ONLY. CUSTOMER SERVICE LINE WILL BE CONNECTED TO THE METER BY THE CUSTOMER OR CONTRACTOR; WATER SHALL NOT BE TURNED ON UNTIL AN INSPECTION OF THE CONNECTION HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND PASSED BY A NPW EMPLOYEE. NONCOMPLIANCE OF THIS MAY BE SUBJECT TO A \$250.00 TAMPERING FEE.

IF A BOOSTER PUMP IS NEEDED TO MEET THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH MINIMUM REQUIREMENT OF 30 PSI AT THE WATER METER THE COST OF A PUMP AND ALL NECESSARY EQUIPMENT PERTAINING TO IT, INCLUDING A DOUBLE CHECK VALVE, SHALL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE APPLICANT. AFTER INSTALLATION AND APPROVAL, THE DISTRICT WILL PAY FOR ALL MAINTENANCE INCLUDING YEARLY TESTING FOR DCVA REQUIRED BY NPW.
